

You may have read the Hills Crescent this past week and noticed where the Hills-Beaver Creek School Board took action on several issues regarding the proposed high school building project.

1. An election timeline was developed and approved by the school board. A vote will be held on Tuesday, March 9, 2010, from 5:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. regarding the construction of a new high school facility.
2. The polling places have been set for the election on March 9.
 - a. All residents of Springwater Township and the City of Beaver Creek will vote at the Beaver Creek City Hall;
 - b. All residents of Beaver Creek Township will vote at the Beaver Creek Township Hall;
 - c. All residents of the City of Steen will vote at the Steen City Hall (the former bank).
 - d. All residents of Clinton Township will vote at the Clinton Township Hall; and
 - e. All residents of Martin Township and the City of Hills will vote at the Hills Legion Hall.
3. A resolution calling for issuance of school building bonds not to exceed \$9,900,000 was also approved. The official ballot is as follows:
