	Set high academic standards and ensure students achieve, on average, above state and national proficiency levels.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Districtwide, the "All Students" group will realize an upward trend over the next three years generating a proficiency rate increase of 5 percent to 10 percent in mathematics and reading, as measured by Minnesota's approved assessments. Districtwide, all identified student subgroups will realize an upward trend over the next three years resulting a proficiency rate increase of between 5 percent to 10 percent in mathematics and reading, as measured by Minnesota's approved assessments.
FINANCES AND BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS	Effectively manage the school district's resources and ensure fiscal responsibility when implementing school district expenditures and allocation of resources to various funds.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Implement a five-year budget plan with a goal of establishing a 20 percent general fund budget reserve that reflects the needs of buildings and grounds, technology, busing, and students. Prioritize expenditures to meet the needs of the school district based on school board deeming necessary. Promote the school district based on stable to growing enrollment, student achievement, welcoming communities, and meeting the needs of all students. Develop and implement a quarterly budget reporting format that identifies the percentage of budget designated 'reserve' and defines expenditures.
STUDENT SUPPORT	Provide a comprehensive plan of action to support every student.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Develop and implement a plan for establishing grades K-12 research-based student learning "programs" (e.g. RTI). Increase graduation rate to state level or above, within three years. Implement interventions for 100 percent of identified students needing academic, social, and/or emotional support.
PERSONNEL	Develop and implement a plan to increase student achievement (i.e., MCAs, ACTs, content-based assessments, etc.) by providing training in educational best practices.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ensure funding to support training and staff development. Develop a process to engage staff in determining valuable training opportunities. Meet the standard of having 25 percent of licensed teachers attend content area specific training yearly and increase staff participation in training incrementally thereafter.
COMMUNICATION AND COMMUNITY RELATIONS	Continue to promote positive school district-related messages and opportunities to Hills-Beaver Creek's internal and external stakeholders.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Identify programs the community believes would strengthen community involvement. Emphasize the education programs and accomplishments of the school district's students, staff, and alumni. Use various methods of communication to inform parents, community, and staff about the school district. Show strong support for the Hills-Beaver Creek schools and community events by encouraging community involvement.
